

Commissioner Reginald Milton was elected to the Shelby County Board of Commissioners in August 2014 as the first representative of the newly formed District 10, which includes Central Gardens, Chickasaw Gardens, Cooper-Young, Midtown, Orange Mound, Overton Square, and South Memphis.

Commissioner Milton is a lifelong Memphian and holds a Master of Public Administration Degree from the University of Memphis with a concentration in Management. He also graduated from LeMoyne-Owen College with a Bachelor of Science Degree. With a career in social service spanning over 20 years, Commissioner Milton has worked for Memphis Planned Parenthood as the Director of Education and Training, City of Memphis as Neighborhood Specialist and for the past 15 years he has been the Executive Director of the South Memphis Alliance which serve children in foster care and families in need.

Commissioner Milton has been an active member of several civic organizations: Mid-South Coalition on HIV/AIDS, Community Development Council of Memphis, Memphis Heritage Association, Leadership Memphis 2009 Executive Class, Literacy Mid-South, Vice Chair of the Shelby County Democratic Party and has served as the Commissioner for Memphis City Beautiful. He is presently a board member for the State of Tennessee Department of Children's Services.
