## **SCEC Holds Voter Registration Events Throughout the County in September**

Sept. 2, 2016 (Memphis, Tenn.) September is National Voter Registration Month, and the Shelby County Election Commission (SCEC) is putting on a series of voter registration events throughout the county during the month.

“To fully embrace National Voter Registration month, we want to provide everyone who is eligible to vote a convenient method to register,” said Linda Phillips, administration of elections for SCEC.

This weekend, voter registration will be available at the Delta Fair & Music Festival outside the main entrance (Gate 1) Saturday, Sunday and Monday from the time the gates open until 7 p.m.

Also, on Sunday, Sept. 4, SCEC will have a table set up at “Rock for Love,” at the Levitt Shell, from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.

On Friday, Sept. 9, SCEC representatives will be at the Goat Days festival in Millington from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.

On Sat., Sept. 10, registration will be available in several locations: The Benjamin Hooks Central Library from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., the Goat Days Festival in Millington from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. and at the Southern Heritage Classic from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

“We are committed to giving as many people, in as many different areas as we can, the opportunity to register and get more information about the election process,” Philllips said.
