

TN-385/I-269 Corridor Economic Development/Environmental Study Public Meeting

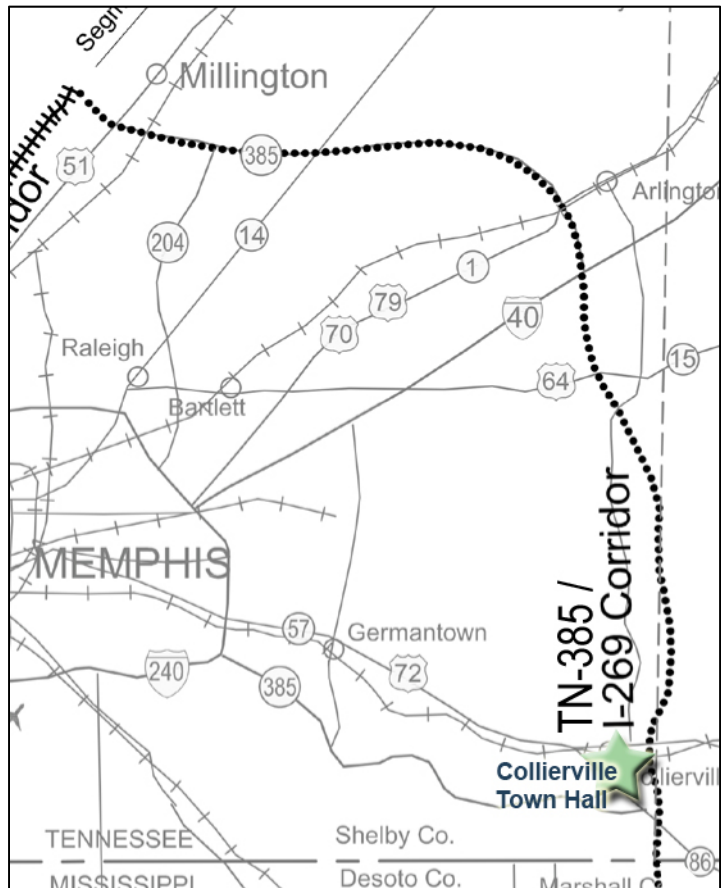
