## **Shelby County Government Prepares for Threat of Freezing Rain**

The Shelby County Office of Preparedness says emergency services coordinators are prepared should freezing rain move into the area tomorrow morning.

**“We’re staying in close contact with the National Weather Service and will be ready to respond should conditions warrant,”** said Dale Lane, Director of the Shelby County Office of Preparedness.

Road crews are prepared should driving become hazardous. **“Our trucks are ready to spread a mixture of salt and sand,”** said Shelby County Public Works Director Tom Needham.
