Winter Weather Advisory for Shelby County-Snow and Sleet Expected

Shelby County may get another round of snow and sleet tomorrow. A Winter Weather Advisory will be in effect from 6 o'clock tomorrow morning through midnight.

“Driving could be hazardous. People should use extreme caution on bridges and overpasses,” said Dale Lane, Director of the Shelby County Office of Preparedness.

Shelby County Public Works trucks will put brine on roads in the unincorporated areas before the precipitation moves in. **“Our salt and sand trucks will be ready when the wintery mix arrives,”** said Tom Needham, Director of Shelby County Public Works.

Tomorrow's high temperature should reach into the mid-30s with tomorrow night's low dipping to the mid-20s.

“As with other recent winter weather events, our staff will say in close contact with emergency services and public works coordinators throughout Shelby County,” added Director Lane.
