



## Shelby County Mayor's Charitable Foundation Scholarship

**Deadline: March 23, 2018 - 4:30 p.m.**

**Available to:** Graduating high school seniors of Shelby County Government employees

**Award Amount:** \$2,000

**Number of Awards:** 6

The Shelby County Mayor's Charitable Foundation Scholarship is **only** open to any graduating high school senior (i.e. public, private, charter, municipal, etc.) whose parent or legal guardian is a current employee of Shelby County Government.

- The applicant must be in good academic standing and complete all requirements to graduate in 2018. Applicants will be evaluated based upon factors such as community involvement, scholastic achievements, and commitment to leadership.
- All applicants are required to complete and submit their application along with the following items:
  - 1) A current high school transcript;
  - 2) One letter of recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor; and
  - 3) An essay of no more than 1,000 words explaining why you are applying for this scholarship.
- The application along with the above-listed documents must be submitted to the Shelby County Education Foundation at P.O. Box 383273, Germantown, Tennessee, 38183.
- To be considered for the scholarship all applications and supporting documents must be postmarked by **Friday, March 23, 2018**.
