New Registration Site for Food Commodities Fair

There's a new location for the Food Commodity Distribution Fair next month:

- Friday, February 17, 2012
- Ed Rice Community Center-2907 North Watkins Avenue, in the Frayser area of Memphis
- 9 a.m. until 1 p.m.

Food commodities are provided to Shelby County Government through the State of Tennessee. Distribution of the food is handled through the Shelby County Division of Community Services.

Eligibility for receiving the food is based on household income requirements. Those who receive assistance from these programs are eligible:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)-formerly known as food stamps
- Families First
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program
- Public Housing Residents
