### **SHELBY COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO DISTRIBUTE OVER 38,000 BOTTLES OF WATER TO SHELBY COUNTY RESIDENTS**

*In partnership with Kroger Delta Division and Tennessee Valley Authority, Shelby County Government will distribute one case of water per vehicle.*

**Shelby County, TN** – Today, December 28, 2022, the Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, in partnership with Kroger Delta Division and Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA), will distribute over 38,000 bottles of water to Shelby County residents who have been impacted by the current Boil Water Advisory.

The water distribution will take place from 2:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. at the Emergency Management and Homeland Security Warehouse, located at 6393 Haley Road. Shelby County Government will distribute only one case of water per vehicle.
