Mayor Luttrell Continues "Meet the Mayor" Sessions

Shelby County Mayor Mark H. Luttrell, Jr. is continuing his monthly one-on-one sessions with citizens to listen to their concerns and suggestions.

"These meetings give me the opportunity to speak personally with citizens about their ideas and ways we can improve Shelby County Government." said Mayor Luttrell.

Meetings will be held on Tuesday, October 16th, Tuesday November 20th and Tuesday, December 18th from 1-4 p.m. at Mayor Luttrell's office on the 8th floor of the Vasco Smith Administration Building, 160 North Main.

Back in July, Mayor Luttrell decided to reserve three hours each month to meet personally with citizens at his office. Since then, 25 people have talked with Mayor Luttrell about everything from road paving to the condition of abandoned properties.

In most instances, citizens got answers to their questions before leaving Mayor Luttrell's Office. The mayor had Shelby County Government division directors available in person or by phone to address the concerns.
